Mr. Cifuentez will explain how the Visalia Municipal Airport affects our land use planning decisions in the western portion of the City and the degree of latitude the City has in making those policy decisions.

5. Begin the Review the Existing and Proposed General Plan Policies for the Conservation, Recreation, Open Space and Parks, and Historic Preservation Elements

Discussion: Using the Conservation, Recreation, Open Space and Parks, and Historic Preservation Elements policies compilation document (included by email and posted to the GP Update website), the GPURC will review those existing General Plan policies that were compiled from the GPURC's earlier reviews in Spring and Summer 2011. In addition, new policies that are being proposed that support the Preferred Plan Map are also included in the document.

This is the second of four scheduled reviews of all of the existing and proposed General Plan policies. As was noted at the October 20th and November 17th GPURC meetings, there is expected to be substantial

interface and exchange between the Map and the Policies, and none will be considered a final product until the GPURC arrives at its final consensus on all of the parts, and directs staff and the consultant accordingly.
